Ways to Watch on Your TV

1. Wirelessly connect your computer, tablet, or phone
  - a. Apple products (Mac computer, iPad or iPhone): follow the instructions on <https://freewheelchairmission.org/apple-wireless>.
  - b. Windows computers: follow the instructions on <https://freewheelchairmission.org/windows-wireless>.
2. Connecting Your Computer with HDMI Cable
  - a. Make sure you have an HDMI cable that is compatible with both your computer and your TV.
    - i. To connect a Mac computer to your TV, follow the instructions on <https://freewheelchairmission.org/mac-tv>.  
You may need to use an HDMI adapter for Macs.
  - b. To connect a Windows computer to your TV, follow the instructions on <https://freewheelchairmission.org/windows-tv>.
3. Smart TVs: If your Smart TV already has the YouTube or Vimeo apps installed, skip ahead to step 5 (YouTube) or 6 (Vimeo).



4. Apple TV, Roku, Firestick, or other streaming devices
  - a. To set up the YouTube app, find your device on <https://freewheelchairmission.org/youtube-app> and follow the instructions.
  - b. To set up the Vimeo app, find your device on <https://freewheelchairmission.org/vimeo-app> and follow the instructions.
5. In the YouTube app, search for “Free Wheelchair Mission” and find our channel.
  - a. Click on our logo. Miracle of Mobility should be the first video that appears on our Vimeo page, starting at 4:15 PM PDT on September 20.
  - b. Press play and enjoy the program.
6. In the Vimeo app, search for “Free Wheelchair Mission” and find us under “Users.”
  - a. Click on our User icon. Miracle of Mobility should be the first video that appears on our Vimeo page.
  - b. Press “play” and enjoy the program.
